

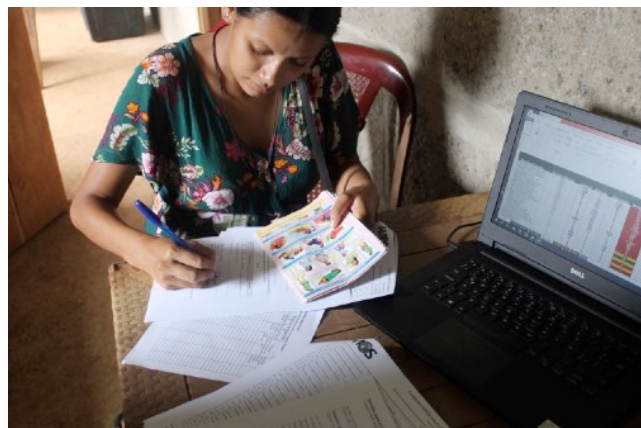
Connected to Care: Harnessing Technology for Healthier Futures



In today's fast-paced technological landscape, the need for efficient tools in healthcare is more urgent than ever. As AMOS Health and Hope expands our reach to serve more communities, embracing digital health technologies is crucial to improving care and saving lives.

The Challenge

Community health volunteers are essential to our mission. These dedicated individuals monitor patient health, identify signs of alarm, and connect families with life-saving care. However, volunteers currently rely on paper records, which are vulnerable to loss or damage. Additionally, with limited internet and cell phone access in Nicaragua, any solution must include a way to sync data once a connection is established.



Fortunately, the majority of our health workers already have a cellphone, making a mobile-based health app the best approach. Many of these apps work offline and automatically sync data to an organization-wide electronic health record system once an internet connection is available. This system centralizes patient information, provides real-time records for AMOS staff, and **optimizes care delivery**.

To implement this project successfully, we require funding for:

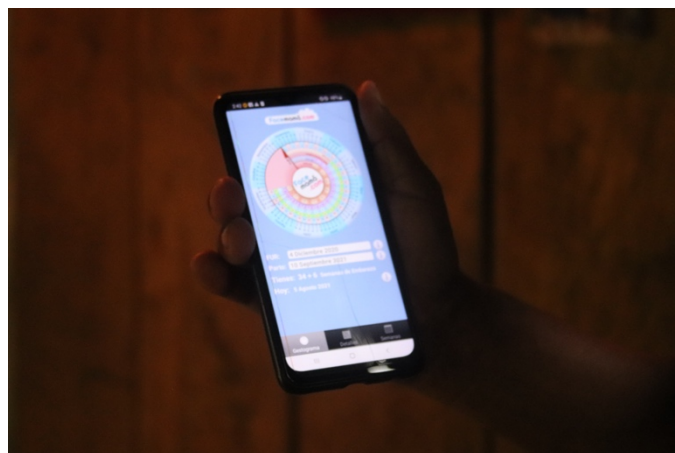
- Technology acquisition (devices and software licenses)
